**CODE OF ETHICS**

***The Profession***

Members must show a total sense of responsibility, practice with integrity, judgement, business capacity and exhibit the highest degree of artistic taste and technical ability and must abide by this code of Professional Practice of the Association.

***The Architect***

Must have an honesty of purpose which is above suspicion. As the professional advisor to his client he must be unprejudiced.

***The Architect's Services***

To advise and counsel his client. To plan, design and offer such technical guidance as may be required to provide the end result sought by his client.

***The Architect-Contractor Relationship***

The Architect must guard equally the interests of the Contractor as well as the Client. The Architect must demand of the Contractor the highest quality of workmanship and material in conformity with the contract documents.

***The Architect-Architect Relationship***

Architects must cooperate in the best interest of the community.

No Architect shall knowingly injure falsely or maliciously the professional reputation, prospects or practice of another Architect.
