- Column 1 also applies to any alteration to a building that will significantly affect the integrity of the architectural aspects, including:
 - The life safety systems, including exits, lobbies and public corridors;
 - The fire compartments, including vertical or horizontal fire separations;
 - The environmental separation systems, including the building envelope; and
 - The usable floor area through the addition of a mezzanine, infill or similar element.
